For an application to be considered, please include:

- CD containing 4-6 high-res images in .jpg format (at least 300 dpi sized to 1920 x 1920 pixels);
- Typed image title list, with dimensions (width and height), materials used and date work was completed (make sure images are numbered in corresponding order to the numbered .jpgs on your disk);
- ONE page resume (highlights only) including exhibition history, awards and/or grants;
- Artist statement reflecting the body of work you are submitting (300 words or less).

Completed applications may be submitted electronically or by mail. Please note: If your submission is incomplete it will not be reviewed or considered. Materials will NOT be returned. Contracts for each show will be made available to artists prior to drop off dates for artwork. To submit an electronic application, please email completed application to info@exploreats.org.

GUIDELINES FOR EXHIBITIONS

Recognizing that art is created with imagination and skill and an individual's representation of thoughts and vision, we in no way wish to censor the work of any one artist. We do, however, respectfully reserve the right to determine if the work submitted for inclusion in any of the exhibits managed by The Arts Center of Clemson is appropriate for the space.

Please follow these guidelines when applying or choosing work for an exhibition to be shown at any of the galleries managed by The Arts Center of Clemson:

1. Please remember that the The Arts Center is open to individuals of all ages and that art will be on display in common areas.
2. The The Arts Center exhibits both two-dimensional and three-dimensional work, including photography, paintings, drawings, mixed media, fabric art, chalk, ink, pastels, graphite, printmaking, pottery and sculpture. Essentially, if we can hang it on a wall or if it fits on our pedestals, we will consider your art for acceptance.
3. All submissions must represent the actual artwork as closely as possible. If your work is misrepresented in anyway, we reserve the right to refuse to hang the artwork if it should be chosen for a show.
4. Digital .jpg files must be named as: First name Last name_Title of the piece_Medium_Height x Width In Inches.jpg making sure that underscores go between your name and the name of the piece (i.e. PabloPicasso_The Old Guitarist_OilOnCanvas_32x48.jpg). IMPORTANT: All items should be SAVED to a CD or emailed. Please write your name and contact information on the disc. Please note: if your submission is incomplete it will not be reviewed. Materials will NOT be returned. The Arts Center reserves the right to refuse any work that does not meet the criteria.
5. The artwork submitted must be the original artwork of the artist and must not infringe on the rights of any other party. The artist must have obtained written permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 18 are featured. The artist is fully responsible to obtain all model or property releases.
6. The condition of artwork must be suitable for satisfactory display. Paintings or wall pieces must be wired and ready to hang. Three-dimensional work must sit solidly on a flat surface. The Exhibition Committee reserves the right to reject any piece of artwork, which, in its opinion, is inadequately prepared for satisfactory display.
7. Works are not always required to be available for sale (accept at shows that are considered "sales"). However, if the Exhibitor wishes to make any works available for sale, all sales will be handled by The Arts Center. Purchasers will pay The Arts Center the full amount of the retail price of the work. A 40% commission will be deducted from that total and the net amount will be paid to the Exhibitor. Checks for any pieces sold will be written the month after the end of the show.
8. Artists will be responsible for delivering and picking up any pieces shown at the The Arts Center by the published dates and times.
9. Promotion and advertising will include an Artist Reception the first Thursday of the exhibition (6–8 p.m.) with beverages provided by ACA. ACA will promote the exhibit on our website, social media outlets, community calendars, member newsletter and by email.
10. The Arts Center has the right to limit the number of works to be shown or that will be for sale by any one artist at any given time.
11. The works in the exhibition will be insured up to the limits of The Arts Center's coverage for the duration of the exhibit. In order to receive this coverage the Exhibitor must complete The Arts Center's Insurance & Condition Document that accompanies the contract for each exhibition.. The Arts Center staff will treat each work with the utmost care and professional handling. All work will be noted by the Center for condition.
